The Artistic Work(s) are the original work(s) of the Artist that may be selected from time to time by School representatives working with TJX. TJX has permission to use the Artist’s name and image to credit the Artist as the creator of the Artistic Work(s), and to promote the sale of merchandise and its packaging bearing, based upon or incorporated into the Artistic Work(s).

In consideration of the recognition of the Artist, the Artist and Parent/Guardian grant TJX permission to copy, modify, publish and distribute the Artistic Work(s), to design merchandise that embodies and displays the Artistic Work(s), and to make, have made, and sell this merchandise in any of its stores. TJX will not pay the Artist or Guardian any money, but will make a payment to the School as described above to assist with the School’s fundraising goals. This permission includes the ability to modify and adapt the work as necessary to create the merchandise.

TJX regrets that it cannot guarantee that all Artistic Works accepted for consideration by TJX will ultimately be used and TJX retains the discretion to use submitted material.

Parent/Guardian represents that he or she is the legal guardian of the Artist with the full power and authority to grant the permission set out above, and to approve the Artist's decision to do the same.

Parent/Guardian and or the Artist have the right to withdraw this authority and permission, in writing, or to request, in writing, that particular Artistic Work be excluded from the program. However, any withdrawal of authority and permission will have no effect on the ability of the School and/or TJX to use Artistic Work selected prior to the withdrawal of authority and permission.

Parent/Guardian and Artist acknowledge that all payment made to the School shall be the exclusive fundraising property of the School.
